Day 1 – Vancouver / VIA Rail

Friday / Sunday

Day 2 – VIA Rail / Jasper

Saturday / Monday

This morning has you waking up to your first views of the Canadian Rocky Mountains. Enjoy meal service the dining car where professional chefs provide delectable cuisine made fresh for your enjoyment. The Park Car offers a lounge, sitting area, and dome seating. Take time to visit the dome seating today and get a 360 degree view of the approaching Canadian Rockies. Late afternoon arrival into Jasper with transfer service to your hotel. *Breakfast and lunch served aboard VIA Rail. Overnight Jasper.*

Day 3 – Jasper

Sunday / Tuesday

Enjoy a half day sightseeing tour of Jasper & Jasper National Park. Visit the Athabasca Viewpoint, Medicine Lake, and gorgeous Maligne Canyon. Summer travelers can also enjoy a boat cruise on Maligne Lake with a tour around Spirit Island. Jasper, located in the heart of Jasper National Park, dates back to 1811 when David Thompson, Canada's great fur-trade era explorer and mapmaker, had his men build the first permanent habitation here while he was searching for a fur-trade route through the Rockies. Visit the Jasper Yellowhead Museum for more information about the history of this world renowned town. *Overnight Jasper.*

Day 4 – Jasper / VIA Rail / Edmonton

Monday / Wednesday

You can also take part mini golf, swim in the Olympic size pool or go skating on the ice rink.
