Day 1 – Winnipeg / VIA Rail

Monday

Day 2 – VIA Rail / Jasper

Tuesday

Day 4 – Banff

Thursday

Today spend time exploring Banff National Park and learn about the history, geology and wildlife of the area. Ride on the Sulphur Mountain Gondola to the top of the mountain, and take in five different mountain regions. This afternoon is yours to explore Banff. Early evening transfer to VIA Rail station.
