Day 1 – Calgary / Banff

Sunday / Tuesday / Thursday

Day 2 – Banff National Park

vehicle will take you up onto the Athabasca Glacier. Continue en-route to Jasper with stops at Crowfoot Glacier, Bow Lake, Peyto lake, & Athabasca Falls. Enjoy the Glacier Skywalk, providing an impressive view of the Canadian Rockies on the newly constructed horse-shoe shaped walkout over the cliffs. Arrival into Jasper early evening. *Overnight Jasper. Buffet lunch included.*

Day 5 – Jasper

Thursday / Saturday / Monday

Begin your morning with a sightseeing tour of Jasper. Your half day tour includes a visit to Athabasca Viewpoint, Medicine Lake, and Maligne Canyon. Summertime visitors can also enjoy a boat cruise on Maligne Lake. Late afternoon at leisure to explore the Jasper townsite. *Overnight Jasper.*
